PRELIMINARY CERTIFICATION OF RESULTS
DEMOCRATIC PARTY OF PUERTO RICO PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARIES
SUNDAY, JUNE 5, 2016

The Puerto Rico Electoral Law, Act 78 of June 1, 2011, as amended, in its Article 10.008 provides:

"Partial and Preliminary Results

- (a) *Partial.- The [Primary] Commission [for the concerned political party] shall combine the results from the polling places of each Electoral Unit of the precincts as they receive them in such a way that it may issue a partial election result no later than twelve o'clock noon of the day following the primary. The partial results will be based on the combination of the results from the polling places received at the time of issuing this result.*
- (b) *Preliminary.- The [Primary] Commission [for the concerned political party] shall report the preliminary results no later than 72 hours after the day of the primary. This result will be based on the combined results of all polling places of each Electoral Unit. This will not lead to the certification of any candidate or applicant. The Commission shall not certify any candidate or applicant until the general canvass has been carried out as provided in the Electoral Law."*

Pursuant to the foregoing, the Primary Commission for the Democratic Party of Puerto Rico reported today, June 8, 2016, that the Preliminary Results for the Democratic Party of Puerto Rico Presidential Primary, held in June 5, 2016 are as follows:



However, the total reported here does not include 2,183 Provisional Ballots nor Write-In ballots as these will be awarded by General Canvassing.



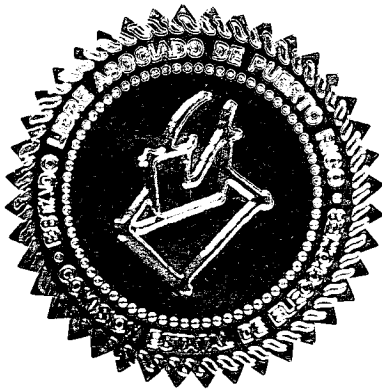
